Although editorial evaluation has shown that this document needs considerable change, it has been accepted for the 5-month DIS enquiry vote in order not to slow progress towards an International Standard.

There are, however, a number of editorial points to be corrected when preparing the revised text of this document for the FDIS vote. These are too many to enumerate here. I would suggest a meeting of the editor with ISO/CS in order to prepare a clearer basis for preparation of the FDIS of this document and for documents to come from TC 67/SC 7 dealing with offshore structures.

It will be necessary to re-examine the titles of this series of documents. It is not recommended to have the same general title for one standard which is a series of parts as the general title for other standards. It has proven most effective to have the part dealing with general requirements as Part 1 of a series, and the other parts dealing with particular requirements as Part 2, Part 3, etc. We should look to rephrase the title main elements of the 19901 series to distinguish them from the 19900, 19902, 19903, etc. documents or confusion will arise. This can be discussed with the SC 7 editor.
