1. Normative references

A number of terms and definitions contain requirements (see point 2) where references have been cited in a normative manner. Please put these requirements in a separate clause and cite the normative reference in the Normative references clause. See for example, 2.2.74 or 2.2.75 (ASTM D2992), 2.2.109 (ISO 14692-2), etc.

2. Terms and definitions

- Use the presentation described in ISO 10241 and annex C of ISO/IEC Directives Part 3, 1997.
- Terms and definitions shall not contain requirements (see C.1.5 of ISO/IEC Directives Part 3, 1997).
- Symbols or abbreviations used for a term belong on a separate line after the term without parentheses.
- The definitions shall be one single phrase and all other information shall be in the form of notes. For instance, see for example 2.2.74 or 2.2.92.

3. Symbols

Symbols for quantities are single letters sometimes with subscripts or other modifying signs. Please see for example, ID which is an abbreviation and not a symbol (d_i or d_{int} would be more suitable) or LTHP which is a pressure (p_{LTH} would be more suitable). See ISO 31 for more information concerning the correct usage of symbols for quantities.

4. Formulae

Please correct equation (1). No formula has been printed out on the paper copy or in the electronic file, only an error message appears.

5. Decimal sign

The decimal sign shall be a comma not a full-stop.
