This document is accepted editorially for the 5-month DIS vote, but several problems should be corrected in the revised text which you submit for preparation for the FDIS vote:

- 1) Please apply the instruction for "Use of Bulleted Paragraphs in ISO/TC 67/SC 6 Standards" which is on your members' website. In particular, point 5 says "A bullet is not required for 'unless otherwise specified' or...", and the given standard phrase explaining bullets should be used in the Introduction (but as full text rather than a Note).
- 2) Figure 2 should be presented as is Figure 1, i.e. with numbers referring to elements in the figure, and these numbers explained in a Key.
- 3) List items which are not complete sentences should begin with lower-case letters, please.
- 4) Do not use "weight" when "mass" is intended. Note that if "weight" is not correct in the SI it is not correct in the USC system either.
- 5) Unless there is a particular reason, it is not necessary to number EVERY sentence, as the text becomes disjointed and not as easy to read.

Thank you for your attention to these details.
