In preparing your text for submission for FDIS, please take into account the following comments:

- 1) The Introduction is strictly informative and thus cannot contain requirements (see 3rd para. last sentence).
- 2) The structure of the definitions should be rewritten in accordance with Directives Part 3, annex C.
- 3) Please also restructure Symbols so each is defined in the singular, with no "are" (or "is"). See any recently published International Standard with a list of symbols.
- 4) A number of definitions are scattered throughout this document which belong in the Terms and definitions clause. It would be much better to define "action" in clause 2 and delete the note in the Scope; likewise for "structure orientation", "splash zone", "scour", "indirect action", "direct action" and as many other "actions" as possible.
- 5) Point 4) follows from the observation that all these "actions" which seem to overlap in definition but not in applied calculation become quite confusing. Careful definition may help sort this out for the user.
- 6) Examples of limit states should be listed as EXAMPLE 1, EXAMPLE 2, etc. under the appropriate item letter in 5.1.2 rather than as separate subclauses.

We look forward to receiving the revised text in due course, after incorporation of DIS comments.
